Safer Internet Day – Tuesday, 11th February

We promoted Safer Internet Day on Tuesday by holding an assembly in Key stage 2 (Years 3-6) to discuss keeping safe online and highlighting the age restrictions on popular apps. We also discussed how to be aware of Phishing and scamming. Foundation pupils (Nursery to Year 2) also discussed how to stay safe online. All Pupils completed activities in their classes around this important theme.
