School Meals

In line with ongoing Welsh Government guidelines, the school meals service plans to review the food served in all Wrexham schools and look at nutritional requirements and healthy options. Wrexham School Meals will be reducing the number of days on which sandwiches are available as a lunchtime option in primary schools.

With effect from Friday 25th April 2025, after the Easter break, sandwiches will no longer be available to pre-order on Fridays, jacket potatoes can still be ordered.

Breakfast Club Payments.

Breakfast Club is available for all pupils from 8:00 am with last entry via the main entrance at 8:30 am. There is a £3 supervision charge per pupil for pupils who arrive before 8:20 am. Pupils who use the Breakfast Club service are required to take a breakfast. **To prevent increasing debts, from Monday 28th April, we ask families who arrive before 8:20 am to please pre-book through ParentPay.** Pupils arriving before 8:20 am but have not pre-booked will be asked to wait in the foyer until 8:20 am before admission. We are changing our booking system after the holidays, all families requiring Breakfast Club will be asked to pre-book for sessions.

Parent Pay

Please phone Mrs Evans in the school office if you need help with Parent pay - we have sent out activation codes for all pupils' accounts - **after the holidays we ask that all families remember to order their children's meal before 8am - ordering meals is taking up a lot of valuable teaching time.** If your child has not pre ordered we cannot guarantee they will receive their first meal preference.
