Coronavirus, COVID-19 - Update -

Ysgol Cefn Mawr, as with all Wrexham schools is receiving regular updates on the management of the Coronavirus, COVID-19, from the Local Authority, Welsh Government and Public Health Wales. We will update you of any further information as we receive it. Key points from this guidance, which we have highlighted to pupils can help to prevent the spread of viruses which includes:

- Washing your hands often with soap and water while singing Happy Birthday twice. Particularly washing before eating any food including snacks. On entry and exit to the childcare setting. After using the toilet and before food preparation.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- If you want to send in some labelled hand cream in to school with your child, they can apply it after washing their hands.
- The importance of catching a sneeze/cough in a tissue, bin it and wash hands afterwards.
