It has been brought to our attention there have been some negative comments on social media about the school this week. Although I am disappointed to hear, I would like to thank the majority of parents for their support during this very difficult time. Closing class bubbles has to occur if there is a positive case in the class, I recognise this is very difficult when children have to self-isolate and parents are working. However, this is an essential measure to stop transmission within school. We have worked very hard over the last 5 years to improve the school and the children's education moving out of a satisfactory school category to a school recognised as having good standards and sharing good practice with others. I can assure you that the staff at this school go over and above every day to ensure your children are safe and have a good education. We are working with Public Health Wales and the Local Authority daily to ensure that the virus is not being transmitted through the school.

Whilst I understand that having Covid-19 positive tests within the school is a worrying time for all, unfortunately, the individuals did not choose to catch the virus and we are indeed suffering from a global pandemic. All of the staff at school are giving up some of their lunchtimes to supervise children and worked three extra weeks last year through their Easter and half term holidays to look after key workers' children. This situation will only improve if we all work together and follow local lockdown guidelines. If individuals have a concern, I would rather you phone the school to discuss your concerns and find out the facts.
