A reminder that we will be holding our Annual Healthy Week next week. Pupils will need to wear a sports kits to school every day and on their sport day please wear a white t-shirt/polo shirt and black/blue shorts/leggings (Tuesday - Nursery-Year 5; Friday - Year 6). Pupils will need to bring a filled water bottle, sun hat and sun cream every day. All classes will be visiting Ty Mawr Country Park or the local playgroup during the week. As part of our Personal, Social & Emotional Curriculum, the children will be given opportunities to learn about:

Years 2-6

- Being aware of own and others' safety
- Discussing feelings & emotions
- Understand respect for selves and others
- Develop an understanding about dangers in the home and outside environment.
- Correct names for the male and female parts of the body

(In Year 2, 3, 4 there is no reference to anything other than the actual names of the body parts. They will learn more about growing up and changes to our bodies they move along through the second part of Key Stage 2)

Year 5 & 6 will also be taught about:

- Body changes
- Hygiene
- Puberty

These lessons are taught by the class teachers, within the children's own classrooms and are age appropriate. Plenty of opportunities are given for the children to talk and ask questions.
