Free School Meals

All primary school pupils are entitled to universal free school meals; however, if you are on a low income or receiving benefits, it is important that you continue to apply for free school meals. Being eligible for free school meals means that further financial help is available for you, including the school essentials grant, music lessons and some school trips. We also receive funding based on the number of eligible pupils who attend our school which means we are able to provide even more learning opportunities for your child. The school essential grant is worth £125 per pupil from Reception to Year 11, and £200 for pupils entering Year 7 (September 2024).
