Closing date for applications 18 November 2024. Parents are reminded that if their child is currently in nursery, there is no guarantee of a place in Reception at that school as a separate formal application must be made.

Free School Meals

All primary pupils are entitled to universal free school meals, but additional support may be available for families who receive eligible free school meals. If you are on Income Support, Income Based Job Seekers Allowance, Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, Income-related Employment Support Allowance, Child Tax Credit - providing you're not entitled to Working Tax Credit with an annual total income below the HMRC set limit, Guarantee element of State Pension Credit, Working Tax Credit 'run-on' - the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit, Universal Credit - if you are working you must be earning less than £7,400 per year (616.67 per month) to qualify for eligible free school meals. If any of the above apply to you, please ask at the school office for a free school meal application.
