North Wales Police - E-Scooters

PC Hulley has asked us to share this information with you to ensure you are aware of the law regarding e-scooters.

It is currently against the law to ride an e-scooter in any public place, including on a public road, cycle lane and pavement. Section 59 of the Police Reform Act allows police to give road users a warning if they are reported to have used their vehicle in a manner which causes harm, distress or annoyance. North Wales Police also have the powers to seize vehicles. North Wales Police want to work with the public to make sure the roads are safe for everyone.
