In Key Stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) doors open from 8:40 am, pupils should not arrive at school too early as they are unsupervised at this time. Doors open for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 from 8:45 am, and for Nursery from 8:50 am.
